

**ANTRIM LAKE - Franklin County, (37 acres) - managed by the city of Columbus, no boats allowed**

**Channel catfish** – These fish are relatively easy to catch for beginners. Try nightcrawlers or shrimp fished on the bottom. Note: bag limit of 6, only one 28" and greater.

**Rainbow trout** - yearling catchable stockings (10-12") are planned for April and October. Good place to take beginning anglers. Use spinners, twister tails, corn, cheese, etc. Fishing may be limited to anglers less than 16 years old in some areas of the lake at some times. Check for signs at the lake.

NOTE: Daily bag limit for trout is five fish. State fishing license required.
