Largemouth Bass **OUTLOOK: GOOD**

Good population of bass with angler catch rates above average. Forty five percent of largemouth bass caught during spring electrofishing surveys were 12" or larger. Consistently a good fishery year after year.

Smallmouth Bass **OUTLOOK: GOOD**

Good population of smallmouth bass. Target rocky areas of lake. In the fall fishing north of the island and below the spillway can be very good.

Crappie **OUTLOOK: GOOD**

Lake was last sampled for crappie in 2004 . Lake contains a good population of crappie 9" or larger. Target woody cover with a jig or jig and minnow.

Saugeye **OUTLOOK: GOOD**

Good population of saugeye that are not heavily fished. Fish up to 24 inches are present with fish greater than 15" common. Fishing below the dam in the tailwaters can be very good after a storm event and in the fall.
