Steelhead Trout

OUTLOOK: **EXCELLENT**

Yearling (smolt) steelhead trout are stocked annually. Steelhead trout average 25". Lake Metroparks and Ashtabula Metroparks provide a good number of fishing access points on the main-stem of the Grand River and its tributaries. Big Creek (accessible at Helen Hazen Wyman Park) is only open to the public upstream to S.R. 86. Kellogg Creek (Helen Hazen Wyman Park) is accessible to the public upstream to Ravenna Road.
