Channel Catfish OUTLOOK: **EXCELLENT**

Yearling channel catfish are stocked by the Division of Wildlife in even-numbered years. The local Izaak Walton League also has provided funds for stocking catfish, as well as other fish species into this pond.

Rainbow Trout **EXCELLENT**

Rainbow trout (10"-14") are stocked each spring by the Division of Wildlife for the annual Little Turtle Pond Trout Derby, which takes place on Saturday, April 17, 2010 between 9:00 AM and 2:00 PM. The Goodyear Hunting and Fishing Club also provide trout for this fine youth event. Fishing opportunities are best following the stockings, but usually continue for another two to three weeks.

NOTES:

Little Turtle Pond is owned by Metroparks Serving Summit County (phone number: 330-867-5511). This pond is part of Firestone MetroPark. The Division of Wildlife stocks both catfish and trout through a management agreement with Metroparks Serving Summit County. This pond also contains largemouth bass and bluegill.
