## North Reservoir

### Largemouth Bass

**OUTLOOK: GOOD**

Largemouth bass were sampled by electrofishing during spring 2008. Thirty-nine percent of the bass sampled were 12" and greater. Nine percent of these fish were also 15" and longer.

### Crappie

**OUTLOOK: FAIR**

White crappie comprised 82% of the crappie sampled by trap-netting in fall 2006. Eighty-three percent of the white crappie sampled measured at least 8", although only a few fish exceeded 10". About 14% of the black crappie sampled measured at least 8", although none of them made it to 10". NOTE: There will be a 9" length limit and daily bag limit of 30 crappie at this lake in 2010.

### Channel Catfish

**OUTLOOK: EXCELLENT**

Yearling channel catfish are stocked in even-numbered years.

### Sunfish

**OUTLOOK: FAIR**

Bluegill were sampled by electrofishing during spring 2008. About 18% of the fish were 6" or longer, but none reached 8".

## NOTES:

Wheelchair accessible shoreline fishing facilities are available. North Reservoir is part of the Portage Lakes chain, although it is not possible to boat between North Reservoir and Long Lake or West Reservoir. North Reservoir is connected to a smaller lake, known as Hower Lake, which is accessible by smaller boats through the bridge opening on State Mill Road.
