

**PETROS LAKE (Stark County)—5 acres, no boats allowed**

**Largemouth bass**—A spring day-time electrofishing survey was conducted during 2006 at this small lake, which is part of Stark County Park District's Petros Park. We captured a small number of bass. Sixty percent of the bass sampled that were at least 8" were at least 12". We did sample some 16" to 20" bass, as well as a number of fish that were less than 8". Even though bass densities are not high at this lake, there are some opportunities to catch some quality-sized fish. OUTLOOK: **FAIR**

**Channel catfish**—A total of 128 yearling (9"+) catfish were stocked in 2007. OUTLOOK: **GOOD**

**Rainbow Trout**—A total of 756 catchable-sized trout were stocked in fall 2008. Approximately 750 10" to 12" rainbow trout are released each year in mid-October to provide fall fishing opportunities. OUTLOOK: **EXCELLENT (October only)**

**Bluegill**—Bluegill were sampled in relatively small numbers during a 2006 spring day-time electrofishing survey. More than 55% of bluegill sampled (base size of 3") measured at least 6". OUTLOOK: **FAIR**
