### Largemouth Bass

#### OUTLOOK: FAIR

Largemouth bass were sampled by electrofishing during spring 2006. Thirty-one percent of the bass sampled were 12" and greater. Two percent of these fish were also 15" and longer.

### Channel Catfish

#### OUTLOOK: EXCELLENT

Yearling channel catfish are stocked during odd-numbered years. Harvested channel catfish averaged 18.5", based on 2007 creel survey results.

### Sunfish

#### OUTLOOK: GOOD

Bluegill were sampled by electrofishing during spring 2006. Twenty-two percent of the bluegill sampled measured 6" and longer. Two percent of the bluegill exceeded 8".

### Rainbow Trout

#### OUTLOOK: EXCELLENT

Rainbow trout (10"-14") are stocked each spring by the Division of Wildlife. Surplus broodstock (ranging from 16" to 28") rainbow trout are released in late November. Fishing opportunities are best following the stockings, but usually continue for another two to three weeks.

## NOTES:

Similar to Aquilla Lake, yet larger, Punderson Lake is another natural "kettle hole" lake, which means the depth drops off quickly (in the main lake) from shore towards the center of the lake.
