Bluegill - Many 4-6" fish present. OUTLOOK: **GOOD**

Channel catfish – Over 11,000 catfish have been stocked since 2002. In 2005, the average length channel cat kept was 13.5 inches, and the largest was 19.5 inches. OUTLOOK: **GOOD**

Crappie – Fair numbers of 8 - 11 inch fish. Average size kept in 2005 was 9.8 inches. OUTLOOK: **FAIR**

Largemouth Bass - Low numbers, most 10-13", some up to 5 pounds. OUTLOOK: **FAIR**

Rainbow Trout - About 2,500 catchable sized trout are stocked in March each year. Easy shoreline access provides great fishing through April. OUTLOOK: **EXCELLENT**
