WILDLIFE HISTORY TIMELINE POSTER

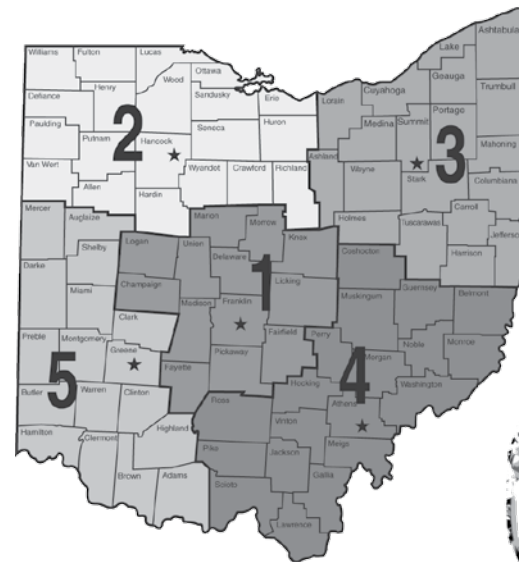

OHIO WILDLIFE FIELD GUIDE SERIES

This series of 12 guides, including two aquatic guides, is an excellent addition to any lesson that focuses on the wide variety of wildlife that is found in the state.

COMMON BIRDS OF OHIO

A field guide of 103 commonly seen birds in Ohio throughout the year accompanied by a CD depicting their calls.

WARBLERS OF OHIO

A publication as well as a CD of calls dedicated to the 50 different warblers that visit our state.

OWLS OF OHIO

This booklet and CD are devoted to the 22 various owls that inhabit or visit Ohio throughout the year.

WATERBIRDS OF OHIO

A publication and CD with 138 species of birds that can be seen in Ohio's wetlands and other aquatic habitats.

DRAGONFLIES AND DAMSELFLIES OF OHIO

A guide with photos and descriptions of 55 species of dragonflies and damselflies found in Ohio.

AMPHIBIANS OF OHIO

This guide colorfully depicts the state's 38 salamanders, toads, and frogs.

REPTILES OF OHIO

A booklet that illustrates 44 species of reptiles including turtles, lizards, and snakes.

BUTTERFLIES AND SKIPPERS OF OHIO

This field guide has photos and descriptions of 61 common butterflies and skippers found in Ohio.

MAMMALS OF OHIO

A booklet that illustrates the 56 diverse mammal species found in Ohio. Includes size references, tracks, and skull illustrations.

COMMON SPIDERS OF OHIO

Photos and descriptions of 63 of Ohio's most common spiders are found in this booklet.



PROJECT WILD SUPPLEMENTS

Project WILD is an interdisciplinary environmental education program with an emphasis on wildlife. Materials include the K-12 guide, Aquatic WILD K-12 guide, Growing Up WILD guide for pre-K, and the Science and Civics guide for High School. BIRDS- SONGS, ADAPTATIONS, AND MIGRATION

Information, activities and illustrations for the study of Ohio birds.

Information and activities on the white-tailed deer, as well as Ohio's deer herd and harvest statistics. Information on non-consumptive and consumptive uses of wildlife is also provided.

Information and activities on wetland habitats including plants, animals, as well as laws and legislation about the protection of these critical areas.

Activities and information regarding the black bear, and its past, present, and future appearance in Ohio.

A supplement where students will be able to learn various adaptations of animals by examining their skulls.

FURBEARERS OF OHIO

Information and activities on Ohio's river otters and other furbearers, as well as information on non-consumptive and consumptive uses of wildlife.

AQUATIC EDUCATION PROGRAMS & MATERIALS

In addition to free training, the Division also offers many educational materials free of charge to educators who wish to bring what's under the water, into the classroom.

The Passport to Fishing Program includes elements of angling skills intertwined with aquatic stewardship to help promote resource and stewardship responsibility. SPORT FISH OF OHIO IDENTIFICATION GUIDE

Ohio's 27 most commonly caught species of fish are represented in this guide. Also contains information on handling, cleaning, bait, and more.

STREAM FISHES OF OHIO

A guide to the 67 species of fish that are commonly found in Ohio's streams.

AQUATIC EDUCATION LOANER TRUNK

This all-inclusive trunk takes aquatics to the extreme. Everything you need to collect, analyze, and ID Ohio's aquatic species. Activities included are based on grade level and meet state standards for student learning. Contact your district office for availability in your area.
