

DEER MANAGEMENT PROJECTS

Many projects about deer management can be developed using the items on this site. The audience for your project may be your teacher, your classmates, other classrooms, local community groups or other organizations.

Project Ideas

- Write a newspaper or website article, including pictures, about the people who manage deer in Ohio.
- Write a persuasive essay to help people understand and appreciate Ohio's deer and deer hunting.
- Construct a multi-media or power point presentation about Ohio's deer herd.
- Develop and give a presentation about deer management, including a visual display.
- Write and produce a play or children's book about deer and deer management.
- Publish a collection of poetry and descriptive writing about deer, including pictures.
- Construct a community survey designed to describe people's attitudes and beliefs about deer and deer management practices.
- Construct a scientific management plan to develop a habitat for deer and to manage the deer within that area.
- Design and conduct a scientific experiment to determine the best non-lethal methods to control deer damage.
- Develop a learning activity or presentation about deer and present it to other classrooms in your school district.
- Identify controversial issues in deer management and develop an event, media production or presentation to explore conflicting viewpoints.
